

Eldora City Council  
Special Council Meeting  
February 2, 2021 -- 5:30 pm

Eldora City Council met in Special Session in the council chamber with Mayor David Dunn presiding. Council members Blake Jones, Greg Priske and Melody Hoy were present, also present was City Administrator Aaron Budweg, Chandra Kyte, Steve Pence and Darrel Meyer in person or by phone.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to go into Closed Session under Iowa Code 21.5(1)(g) and (h). Council member Hoy so moved, seconded by Jones. Roll call vote: “ayes” Hoy, Jones and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: Johns. Motion carried. Closed Session opened at 5:32 pm.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to open the Closed Session. Council member Jones so moved, seconded by Priske. Roll call vote: “ayes” Jones, Priske and Hoy; “nays” none; absent: Johns. Motion carried. The Closed Session closed at 6:05 pm and went into Open Session.

The Mayor introduced Resolution 02-21-2922 Resolution supporting the Eldora Fire and Rescue Grant. They have applied for a grant with Hardin County Endowment to help pay for an industrial washer and dryer to clean the uniforms. Aaron called Steve Pence to ask more about the grant. The washer/dryer bid they received would cost the department \$13,039.28 and they have requested a grant to cover up to 75% of the cost. Since the Fire Dept Trust does not have an EIN, they would use the City’s EIN. Steve was hoping the City Fire Trust could help cover the difference of what the grant would not but could also use the Fire Dept Trust money. Council member Hoy so moved, seconded by Priske to approve Resolution 02-21-2922 with the hope that the fund would first come from the Fire Dept Trust. Roll call vote: “ayes” Hoy, Priske and Jones; “nays”: none; absent: Johns. Motion carried.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to adjourn. Council member Jones so moved; meeting adjourned at 6:22 pm.
