

Eldora City Council
Special Council Meeting
February 21, 2023 -- 6:00 pm

The council gave the option to meet via conference call, Zoom or at the Council Chamber.

Eldora City Council met in Regular Session with Mayor Pro-Tem Jerry Kramer presiding. Council members Cindy Drake, Jerry Kramer, Mike May Jr, and Carey Morton were present along with City Administrator Aaron Budweg, Chandra Kyte and Pat McKenna in the council chamber.

The Mayor Pro-Tem asked for a motion to open the public hearing on the proposed Max Levy 2023-2024 and Council member Morton so moved, seconded by Drake. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Morton, Drake, May Jr, and Kramer; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried. The public hearing opened at 6:05pm. There were no comments. The Mayor Pro-Tem asked for a motion to close the public hearing. Council member Morton so moved, seconded by Drake. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Morton, Drake, Kramer, and May Jr; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried. The public hearing closed at 6:06 pm.

Resolution 02-23-3203, approval of FY 2023-2024 maximum property tax dollars was next. Council member Morton motioned to approve Resolution 02-23-3203, seconded by Drake. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Morton, Drake, May Jr, and Kramer; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried.

Council member Drake motioned, seconded by Morton to approve Resolution 02-23-3204, setting hearing date for appointment of council member. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Drake, Morton, May Jr, and Kramer; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried. Council will let the Mayor or Aaron know of any suggested council members.

Next was Resolution 02-23-3205, authorizing Mayor Pro-Tem to sign agreement with Blake Jones. Council member Drake motioned, seconded by Morton to approve Resolution 02-23-3205. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Drake, Morton, May Jr, and Kramer; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried.

The Mayor Pro-Tem introduced two grant applications with the Hardin County Community Endowment Foundation. Council member Drake motioned, seconded by Morton to support Eldora Area Chamber of Commerce application for the Pine Lake Festival live band and DJ project. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Drake, Morton, Kramer, and May Jr; “nays”: none; “absent”: vacancy. Motion carried. Council member Morton motioned, seconded by Drake to approve Resolution 02-23-3206, pledging support for the Hardin County Community Endowment Foundation grant application. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Morton, Drake, May Jr, and Kramer; “nays”: none; “absent” vacancy. Motion carried.

The council members gave their communications at this time. Aaron said Iowa Realty has backed out on showing the clinic because they can not sell as “bidding on property” so the City will advertise themselves the property.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kramer for a motion to adjourn. Council member Drake so moved; meeting adjourned at 6.15pm.
