

Eldora City Council  
Special Council Meeting  
June 7, 2021 -- 5:30 pm

Eldora City Council met in Special Session in the council chamber with Mayor David Dunn presiding. Council members Greg Priske, Cindy Johns, Jerry Kramer, Melody Hoy, and Blake Jones were present. Also attending the meeting was City Attorney Erika Allen, City Administrator Aaron Budweg and Chandra Kyte. Present for the meeting was Nick Hassebrock, Matt Rezab, Sarah Carson Mike Galloway, Andrew and V60 ThinQ 5G UW either in person or by Zoom.

The Mayor asked for a motion to open the Public Hearing and Council member Jones so moved, seconded by Kramer to open the Public Hearing. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Jones, Kramer, Johns, Hoy and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried. The Public Hearing opened at 6:01pm.

Aaron explained the amended budget process with the council. It was reviewed with the Finance Committee earlier and the City has more revenue and expenses this year with a net excess revenue around 214k.

The Mayor asked for a motion to close the Public Hearing and Council member Johns so moved, seconded by Jones to close the Public Hearing. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Johns, Jones, Kramer, Hoy and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried. The Public Hearing closed at 6:04 pm.

The Mayor introduced Resolution 06-21-2951, Resolution amending the current budget for the fiscal year ending 6-30-2021. Any excess money in each Fund Account will roll over to that Fund Account. Council member Jones so moved, seconded by Kramer to approve Resolution 06-21-2951. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Jones, Kramer, Hoy, Johns and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried.

The Mayor introduced Ordinance 873, amending Chapter 99, Sewer Service Charge. Per the Ordinance, the fee would go from \$8.00 to \$10.00 starting July 1, 2021, and Ordinance 873 would change this. The rate will only be \$8.50 starting July 1, 2021. Council member Johns so moved, seconded by Jones to hold the first reading of Ordinance 873. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Johns, Jones, Kramer, Hoy and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried.

The Mayor asked for a motion to open the Closed Session per Iowa Code 20.17(3) and Council member Kramer so moved, seconded by Hoy to open the Closed Session. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Kramer, Hoy, Johns, Priske and Jones; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried. The Closed Session opened at 6:23 pm.

The Mayor asked for a motion to close the Closed Session and Council member Jones so moved, seconded by Hoy to close the Closed Session. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Jones, Hoy, Johns, Kramer and Priske; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried. The Closed Session closed at 6:47 pm and went back to open meeting.

Council member Kramer motioned, seconded by Hoy to approve the red line version of the Union Contract, and give authority to the Mayor to sign the final version of the proposed Union Contract. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Kramer, Hoy, Priske and Jones; “nays”: Johns; absent: none. Motion carried.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to adjourn. Council member Hoy so moved; meeting adjourned at 6:50 pm.
