**RESOLUTION SETTING FINES FOR FIREWORKS VIOLATIONS**

**BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE Council of the City of Eldora, Iowa:

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eldora, Iowa desires to set fines for fireworks violation as set by Code 41.11 Fireworks as stated below:

4. **Violations.** All violations of any provisions of this Chapter are hereby declared simple misdemeanors and/or municipal infractions. Violations may be prosecuted as either a misdemeanor criminal offense or a municipal infraction at the sole discretion of the fire chief or peace officer. Fines shall be set by resolution of the City Council. Violations of this chapter shall be reported to the state fire marshal.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, BY THE Council of Eldora, Iowa, that the fine for fireworks violation will follow the municipal infractions rate of \$75.00 for first offense and \$250.00 for every one thereafter offense within a one year period from the first offense.
