RESOLUTION NO. 11-18-2777

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ALLOCATION OF INTERSTATE LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY
FRANCHISE FEES

WHEREAS, the existing franchise agreement between Alliant, also known as Interstate Light and Power Company and the City of Council was renewed December 2011, and

WHEREAS, the current franchise fees are collected and distributed as 9% to Economic Development, 65% Police and 26% Street Department.

WHEREAS, the revenues collected are to be allocated as follows:

1. Inspection, supervising and otherwise regulating the franchise approved by the City;
2. The repair, remediation, restoration, cleanup, replacement and improvement of existing public improvements and other publicly owned property, buildings and facilities;
3. Projects designed to prevent or mitigate future disasters as defined in Iowa Code Section 29C.2;
4. Public Safety, including the equipping of fire, police, emergency services, sanitation, street and civil defense departments;
5. The establishment, construction, reconstructing, repair, equipping, remodeling and extension of public works, public utilities and public transportation systems
6. The construction, reconstruction or repair of streets, highways, bridges, sidewalks, pedestrian underpasses and over passes, street light fixtures, public grounds and the acquisition of real estate needed for such purposes;
7. Economic Development activities and projects;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eldora would like to distribute the franchise fees collected as following: 9% General, 65% Police and 26% Street Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Eldora, Iowa, hereby directs the Deputy City Clerk distribute the collected franchise fees as listed.
