Account ending in 7977 – Comm Garden - remove all previous signers; require one signatures from - Aaron Budweg

Account ending in 4574 – Play Ground - remove all previous signers; require two signatures from Chandra Kyte, Audrey DeVilder, Leslee Perry or Aaron Budweg

Account ending in 7010 – Super Saver - remove all previous signers; require one signatures from Chandra Kyte, Brenda Wical or Aaron Budweg
