RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING STREET CLOSING FOR THE HARDIN COUNTY FAIR  
PARADE

**WHEREAS**, the Hardin County Fair Board has requested that the following streets be closed for the purpose of conducting the Hardin County Fair Parade on Wednesday, July 10, 2019:

15<sup>th</sup> Street south to Edgington Avenue; east on Edgington Avenue to Washington Street to 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue; east on 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 12<sup>th</sup> Street; north on 12<sup>th</sup> Street to 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue; then east on 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the Fairground.  
Highway 175 closed from 15<sup>th</sup> Street east to 10<sup>th</sup> Street

**WHEREAS**, such street closings would not adversely affect residents or businesses in the area.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Eldora hereby approves closing the above listed streets for the purpose of conducting the Hardin County Fair Parade on July 10, 2019 from 5:45 p.m. to 7:15 p.m.
