RESOLUTION SETTING THE FISCAL YEAR 21/22 SALARIES AND WAGES FOR THE CITY OF ELDORA EMPLOYEES

**WHEREAS**, the City Code requires that the City Council establish employee compensation by Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agreed to a Union Contract with the intent of the terms of that contract acting as a guide to be applied to non-union employees unless otherwise stated; and

**WHEREAS**, seasonal employees, unless otherwise stated below, receive raises upon rehire at the start of the season.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Eldora hereby sets City non-union employee wages effective on the July 9, 2021 payroll. These raises include: full-time employees and full-time part-time employees as listed on the attached sheet.

Union Employees as negotiated by Union Contract

Police: \$1.00 increase per hour

Public Works & Water/Sewer: 2.50% increase per hour

Non-union Employees – full time, full time part-time See attached form

Full Time Salaried Employees See attached form
